Cost of Ministry

In 2021, as part of *Time to Change Together*, the average cost of a stipendiary minister was calculated and fixed at £55,000.

The diocese has used this figure over the past five years to help parishes understand the cost of ministry. As with all costs, however, this figure has increased over time and we need to be honest about how this has impacted the cost of ministry. For 2027 the actual cost is now calculated to be £64,500. Since 2021 this represents average annual growth of around 2.7%

Our PCC's and Local Mission Partnerships will now have informed conversations on how best to support our shared ministry.
